 - Learn about **ENERGY STAR® QI** and how to become a **Premier Contractor** in the COOL SMART program
 - ENERGY STAR QI blends an industry-accepted set of installation guidelines, based on ACCA QI specifications, with the ENERGY STAR label to ensure that consumers receive high-quality installations
- Expansion of the full COOL SMART program to new sponsor areas in Massachusetts

- Beginning in February we will offer:
 - Free Wrightsoft Manual J training (Prerequisite: you must own a working copy of Wrightsoft Manual J software). Note: We encourage you to take advantage of this offer, as load calculations are likely to become mandatory next year.
 - Quality Installation Verification (QIV) refresher trainings: All technicians will be required to attend a refresher class prior to performing QIV in 2010.
- **NATE Certification** – [A “tuition reimbursement” of up to \\$250](#) will continue to be offered for technicians becoming NATE certified in Air Conditioning or Heat Pump Service and/or Installation in 2010.
- **Opportunities for Federal Tax Credits** – High-efficiency HVAC equipment may also qualify for Federal Tax Credits. Visit www.energystar.gov/taxcredits for more information. Note: Not all ENERGY STAR products will qualify for the tax credit.
